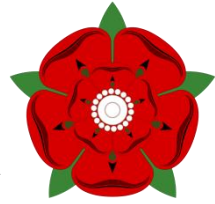


# *The Red Rose Ramble*



**SUNDAY 16 AUGUST 2020**

## **SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**



**ORGANISED BY THE PRESTON & DISTRICT VINTAGE CAR CLUB**

## **1. DEFINITION OF EVENT**

- 1.1 The Red Rose Ramble of 2020 is a non-competitive scenic tour.
- 1.2 The event will be open to Vintage, PVT, Historic, Classic and 'interesting' modern cars.
- 1.3 The event will take place on Sunday 16 August 2020.

## **2. ORGANISATION OF EVENT**

- 2.1 Organised by The Preston and District Vintage Car Club (PDVCC)
- 2.2 The event is organised in accordance with the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (MSUK) [incorporating the International Sporting Code of the FIA] together with these Regulations and any additional instructions that may be issued by the event organisers. All Entrants undertake to comply with these Regulations by the fact of their entry.
- 2.3 A MSUK Certificate of Exemption will be applied for.

## **3. THE ROUTE**

- 3.1 The 'standard' route is approx 100 miles long on tarmac, public roads. There will be several optional loops which can be used to shorten or lengthen the route should entrants wish. The longest route will be approx 130 miles.
- 3.2 The route will take entrants through beautiful Lancashire countryside over some of the best driving roads in the north-west of England, including the famous Trough of Bowland. Some old 'motorsport' roads of the past will be included.
- 3.3 All route instructions will be published in a clear, easy to read Road Book and will consist of 'tulip' diagrams, distances, sign-posts etc.
- 3.4 The instructions will contain details of petrol stations, toilets and possible picnic sites en route.

## **4. THE START/FINISH**

- 4.1 The Start and Finish will be at West Bradford Village Hall, Grindleton Road, West Bradford, Clitheroe BB7 4TE. OS 103:747448. WBVH is located in the scenic Ribble valley near Clitheroe.
- 4.2 Trailers and tender cars are not allowed at the Start/Finish venue.
- 4.3 Signing-On will open at 09.00. Cars will start at one minute intervals, in an order decided by the organisers, from 10.00. A generous overall time allowance will be given for the event. The post run meal will be at 17.30. All times will be confirmed in the Final Instructions.

## **5. ELIGIBILITY**

- 5.1 The Event is open to any of the following cars:-
  - (a) Vintage – manufactured before the end of 1930
  - (b) Post Vintage Thoroughbred – manufactured between 1931 and 1940
  - (c) Historic – manufactured between 1941 and 1985
  - (d) Classic – any 'interesting' post 1985 cars
  - (e) The maximum number of entries is 50. The minimum number of entries is 24.

NB Once 40 entries have been received preference will be given to classes a, b & c.

- 5.2 The Event is open to any member of the following clubs:- PDVCC, VSCC, HRCR, LAC, TOC, IDMC, FSAC, A&PMC, Riley Register, PWA7, MGO, MGCC, Morris Register, Alvis OC, 12/50 Club.
- 5.3 Anyone wishing to enter who is not a member of any of the above clubs may join the PDVCC on the day for a fee of £10.00 (valid until end of 2020)

## **6. ENTRIES**

- 6.1 Entries open with the publication of these Supplementary Regulations.
- 6.2 The entry fee is £50.00 per car. This 'Early Bird' rate applies to entries received by 30 June 2020.
- 6.3 Entries received on or after 1 July 2020 will be charged £60.00 per car.
- 6.4 Entries will close on Sunday 9 August 2020.
- 6.5 In the event of the Red Rose Ramble being over-subscribed entries will be accepted on a 'first-come, first-served' basis.

- 6.6 Entries must be made on the official Entry Form and will only be considered complete upon payment of the Entry Fee.
- 6.7 Entry fees include food for a crew of two (see para 7 below)
- 6.8 Additional passengers can be carried, up to the maximum number of seats in the car. Additional passengers should pay £20.00 per head to cover the cost of their food.

- 6.10 Payment should be made at the time of entering and can be paid by either:-

## 7. WHAT IS INCLUDED?

- 7.1 The entry fee includes:-
- (a) An easy to follow detailed Road Book
  - (b) A numbered Souvenir Rally Plate which must be displayed on the front of the car for the duration of the event
  - (c) Food for a crew of two as follows: Participants will be served with a bacon roll and tea/coffee at the start. A packed lunch will be supplied that may be eaten en route. The Ramble will end with a meal of traditional Lancashire Hot Pot. A bar will be available at the finish. Vegetarian options maybe ordered.

## 8. INSURANCE

- 8.1 Entrants and drivers MUST have valid insurance for this type of event with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act and relevant laws applicable in Great Britain.

## 9. DOCUMENTATION

- 9.1 The following current and valid documents should be available for inspection at Signing-On:- Driving License, MOT Test Certificate (if applicable), Current Motor Insurance Certificate
- 9.2 The new MSUK RS Clubman License **IS NOT** required
- 9.3 You are also recommended to carry the following in the vehicle: A first aid kit, a warning triangle, a fire extinguisher, hi viz jackets or tabards for each occupant of the car.

## 10. INSTRUCTIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS

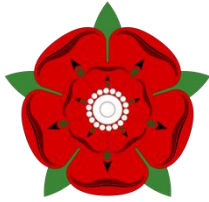
- 10.1 Any additional instructions will be deemed to be an appendix to and have the same power as these Supplementary Regulations.

## 11. JURISDICTION

- 11.1 The Organisers have absolute discretion in the application and amendment of a penalty for any breach of these Regulations and may implement decisions on any matter not provided for in these Regulations.
- 11.2 The organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event should circumstances arise which cause such action desirable or necessary. In such circumstances the return of fees, in whole or part, will be at the discretion of the organisers.

## 12. DATA PROTECTION ACT

- 12.1 Information on this event involving entrants is held on computer but is for Club purposes only in connection with motorsport activities.
